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PSC Regular Meeting – Thursday, November 7, 2024

Waste Management Matters

US VIRGIN ISLANDS – The Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (PSC or the Commission) met for its regular meeting on Thursday, November 7, 2024.

The Public Services Commission is not funded through appropriations of the Legislature but through assessments of its regulated utilities, as required in Virgin Islands law. On October 18, 2024, the Virgin Islands Waste Management Authority (WMA) filed a Petition for Reconsideration of its Annual Assessment.

At the recommendation of PSC Staff, the Commission voted to grant WMA's Petition for Reconsideration. Staff will issue a schedule of briefings, to permit WMA to fully explain its position and to afford PSC staff the opportunity to analyze and respond prior to a formal hearing on this matter that will take place at the Commission's February 2025 meeting.

Commissioners in attendance included Chairman Pedro Williams, David Hughes, Raymond Williams, Clement Magras, and Laura Nichols-Samms. Ex-officio members Senator Carla Joseph and Senator Marise James were absent.

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
