WHEREAS, after review and deliberation, the Commission voted to GRANT LRE Solar certification as a QF on St. Croix, US Virgin Islands; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission finds and **ORDERS** that, LRE Solar's Application for certification as a QF on St. Thomas USVI is **GRANTED**.
