WHEREAS, on February 12, 2014, the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (hereinafter "the Commission or PSC") received a written complaint from Solar Delivered, seeking participation in the Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority's (hereinafter "WAPA" or the "Authority") Net Metering program for their client, Subway Restaurant, located in Sunny Isles Food Court, Christiansted St. Croix; and

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2014, the PSC's staff, members of the Authority's staff, Solar Delivered and a representative from the Sunny Isles management office met in an informal meeting via conference to address matters in the complaint, an agreement was unable to be deemed and the parties were informed that matter would be discussed at the next PSC's meeting; and

WHEREAS, after hearing from the complainant and from the Authority; and

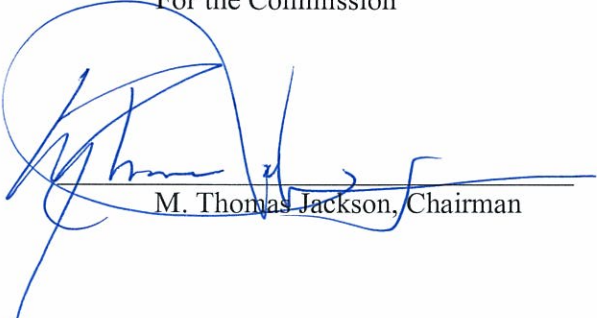
