**ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, on March 25, 2013, the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission received Petitions for Modification from the Virgin Islands Telephone Corporation d/b/a Innovative Telephone (hereinafter "Vitelco" or "Innovative") to modify and amend Docket 549, Order No. 18/2013 and Docket 610 Order No. 19/2013; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 26, 2013, the Commission met in public session in the Commission's offices on both St. Thomas and St. Croix; and

**WHEREAS**, upon review and deliberation the Commission voted to grant the Petition for Modification for Docket 549, Order No. 18/2013 and to direct the issuance of an amended order in compliance with Vitelco's Petition; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission also voted that Docket 610, Order No. 19/2013 be modified to direct that the benefits unpaid in the amount of \$29,000.00 be added to the accrued fund for Life Line and paid over to the Commission for the promotion of further uses of the Life Line program; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby **ORDERED**:


1. That the Petition of Modification for Docket 549, Order No. 18/2013 be **GRANTED**.
2. To direct the issuance of an amended order in compliance with Vitelco's Petition.

3. That Docket 610, Order No. 19/2013 be modified to direct that the benefits unpaid in the amount of \$29,000.00 be added to the accrued fund for Life Line and paid over to the Commission for the promotion of further uses of the Life Line program.
