ORDER


WHEREAS, on May 14, 2007, the United States Virgin Islands Public Services Commission met in regular session on St. Thomas;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title 30, section 18, of the Virgin Islands Code, the Public Services Commission may appoint an agent for the purpose of investigating issues related to any public utility; and

WHEREAS, upon consideration and deliberation, the members of the Commission voted to authorize its General Counsel Tanisha Bailey-Roka, Esq. to meet with representatives from the Virgin Islands Port Authority, Virgin Islands Police Department, and Ferry Franchise Companies Varlack Venture, Inc., and Transportation Services Inc. to discuss and create ways of improving the service and safety of ferry passengers;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the Motion to appoint General Counsel Tanisha Bailey-Roka, Esq. as the authorized agent of the Public Services Commission to meet with the VIPA, VIPD, and the Ferry Franchise Companies is GRANTED.
