Code Ann. *tit.* 30, §25;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED, that Centennial Communications Corporation pay the sum of \$20,000.00 within twenty (20) days of the date of this Order, to be deposited in the Treasury of the United States Virgin Islands in a special account to be maintained and administered by the Commissioner of Finance designated Special Public Utility Deposit Account as prescribed by law.
