ORDER

WHEREAS, the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (hereinafter, "PSC" or "the Commission") received a petition ("Petition") from the Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority (hereinafter "the Authority") on June 4, 2008, wherein the Authority petitioned the Commission to reinstate the monthly automatic Levelized Energy Adjustment Clause ("LEAC"); and

WHEREAS, the Commission received this petition after the agenda for the Commission's next regularly scheduled meeting was published; and

WHEREAS, the LEAC is already addressed through Docket 289; and


WHEREAS, the Commission met in regular session in the PSC offices in Barbel Plaza on St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on June 10, 2008; and

WHEREAS, upon deliberation and consideration, the Commission voted to consolidate WAPA's Petition to Reinstate the Automatic LEAC with the ongoing investigations in Docket 289 and be considered and adjudicated in subsequent LEAC proceedings but in no event to exceed eight (8) months from the date of the filing of the petition; and

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Petition for the Automatic LEAC be consolidated with current LEAC investigations in Docket 289 and be considered and adjudicated in subsequent LEAC proceedings but in no event to exceed (8) months from the date of the filing of the petition.
