ORDER GRANTING CERTIFICATION AS A QUALIFIED FACILITY


WHEREAS, on August 22, 2008, the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (hereinafter "PSC" or "the Commission") met on St. Thomas, Virgin Islands in the Commission's offices located in Barbel Plaza; and


WHEREAS, on or about May 29, 2008, the Commission received an application from Seven Seas Water for certification as a qualified facility pursuant to the Small Power Production and Cogeneration Act of the Virgin Islands (30 V.I.C. § 46 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, upon deliberation and consideration of the aforementioned application and the information contained which meet the requirements of 30 V.I.C. §46(o) and meet the definition set forth in 30 V.I.C. §46(j)(1) and (2) and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, the Commission voted unanimously to approve the certification of Seven Seas Water Corp.; and

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the application for certification is **GRANTED**.
