**AMENDED ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, on February 22, 2008, the Public Services Commission (“PSC” or “Commission”) granted Centennial USVI Operations (hereinafter “Centennial”) petition for designation as an Eligible Telecommunication Carrier ( hereinafter “ETC”) in the U. S. Virgin Islands pursuant to Virgin Islands Act No. 6977 and the Federal Communications Act of 1996; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 5, 2008, Centennial filed with the Commission its annual report and request to continue its ETC designation; and

**WHEREAS**, Centennial has fulfilled its obligations as an ETC in the U. S. Virgin Islands pursuant to Virgin Islands Act. No. 6977, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC); and

**WHEREAS**, on September 25, 2008, the Commission met in regular session at the PSC Offices located in Barbel Plaza, St.Thomas; and

**WHEREAS**, upon deliberation and consideration the Commission voted unanimously to continue the designation of Centennial as an ETC in the U. S. Virgin Islands; and


**NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Centennial be re-certified to continue its designation as an ETC in the U. S. Virgin Islands is **ADOPTED**.

It is hereby **ORDERED** that Centennial be re-certified and continue its ETC designation in the U. S. Virgin Islands is **GRANTED**.
