**AMENDED ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, on October 24, 2008, the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission ("PSC" or "Commission") met in regular session at the Westin Resort and Villas in St. John, Virgin Islands; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Title 30, section 18, of the Virgin Islands Code, the Commission has the authority to appoint an agent for the purpose of investigation of any public utility; and

**WHEREAS**, the Virgin Island Telephone Company (hereinafter "VITELCO") is a public utility subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been more than five years since the completion of the last rate investigation of VITELCO; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has initiated a formal rate investigation of VITELCO pursuant to Section 20 of Title 30 of the Virgin Islands Code; and


**WHEREAS**, the Commission after deliberation and review, and upon recommendation of its staff, appointed David M. Nissman, Esq., to preside over the rate investigation as hearing examiner; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby **ORDERED** that David M. Nissman, Esq., is appointed as the hearing examiner in docket 578.
