**WHEREAS**, on June 4, 2008, the Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority ("WAPA" or "the Authority") filed a petition with the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission ("PSC" or "the Commission") for authorization to reinstate the automatic Levelized Energy Adjustment Clause ("LEAC"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission met in regular session on November 12, 2008 in the PSC offices located in Barbel Plaza, St. Thomas; and

**WHEREAS**, after careful review and deliberation the Commission voted to:

1. Not reinstate the automatic LEAC.
2. Reduce the review time for the LEAC from six (6) months to three (3) months


**NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby **ORDERED**, that:

1. The petition to reinstate the automatic LEAC is not approved.
2. The review of the LEAC is reduced from six (6) months to three (3) months.
