**WHEREAS**, the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (“PSC” or “Commission”) pursuant to Order 54/2008 (see attached) implemented a one dollar and ten cents (\$1.10) fuel surcharge to all categories of tickets for Varlack Ventures, Inc. and Transportation Services of St. John, Inc. (collectively, “Ferryboat Franchisees”); and

**WHEREAS**, the price of fuel has decreased substantially since the implementation of the fuel surcharge; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 1, 2009, the Commission met in regular session in Barbel Plaza on St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands; and


**WHEREAS**, upon deliberation and consideration, the Commission voted to rescind the fuel surcharge on all categories of tickets for the Ferryboat Franchisees, effective immediately; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby **ORDERED**, that the fuel surcharge on all categories of tickets for the Ferryboat Franchisees is rescinded.
