ORDER

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2009, the Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority (“WAPA” or “the Authority”) filed a petition with the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (“PSC” or “the Commission”) requesting authorization to use up to five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) from the Self-Insurance and Hazard Mitigation Fund; and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2009, the Commission met in regular session at its offices located in Barbel Plaza on St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands; and


WHEREAS, upon deliberation and consideration, the Commission voted to allow the authority to use up to five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) from the Self-Insurance and Hazard Mitigation Fund to finance the purchase of fuel inventory for the 2009 Hurricane Season; and

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Authority is authorized to use up to five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) from the Self-Insurance and Hazard Mitigation Fund to finance the purchase of fuel inventory for the 2009 Hurricane Season.
