ORDER

WHEREAS, on April 16, 2009, pursuant to Title 30, Section 33, of the Virgin Islands Code, the Virgin Islands Unity Day Group, Inc. (hereinafter, "the Petitioner") filed a Petition to Reconsider with the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (hereinafter, "PSC" or "the Commission") seeking reconsideration of PSC Order 27/2009; and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2009 the Commission granted the Petition to Reconsider and memorialized its decision in PSC Order 30/2009; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2009, the Commission met in regular session at its offices located at Barbel Plaza, St. Thomas, U. S. Virgin Islands; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title 30, Section 18 of the Virgin Islands Code, the Commission has the authority to appoint an agent for the purpose of making an investigation with regard to any public utility; and


WHEREAS, upon deliberation and consideration the Commission voted to appoint Avery K. Williams as Technical Consultant for PSC Docket 573; and

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED**, that Avery K. Williams is appointed Technical Consultant for PSC Docket 573.
