**ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, on August 24, 2010, the Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority (hereinafter, "WAPA" or the "Authority") filed its petition with the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (hereinafter, "PSC" or the "Commission") seeking to raise the Levelized Energy Adjustment Clause ("LEAC") electric factor from \$0.251336 per kWh to \$0.256681 per kWh and to raise the water factor from \$10.04 per kGal to \$13.78 per kGal; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 17, 2010, the Commission's consultants filed their report and analysis with the Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 24, 2010, WAPA filed an amendment to its petition concerning the LEAC rates and requested that instead of increasing the rates, the rates be held at the present levels for the month of October 2010 so that WAPA could make another filing concerning a possible refinancing; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 28, 2010, the Commission met in regular session at its offices located at Barbel Plaza, St. Thomas, U. S. Virgin Islands, and

**WHEREAS**, upon review and deliberation, the Commission voted to decrease the electric system LEAC factor to \$0.248430 per kWh and to keep the water system LEAC factor of \$10.04 per kGal effective on all bills rendered from October 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010; and


**NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. The electric system LEAC factor is decreased from \$0.251336 per kWh to **\$0.248430** per kWh effective on all bills rendered from October 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010.
2. The water system LEAC factor is kept at **\$10.04** per kGal effective on all bills rendered from October 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010.
