WHEREAS, on June 30, 2011, Sen. Alicia Hansen filed a “Petition For Request For Stay And Reconsideration Of LEAC Order” with the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Commission had already noticed a meeting for July 12, 2011, on July 1, 2011, an amended agenda was produced and released to the public, adding Sen. Hansen’s Petition to the agenda; and


WHEREAS, on July 5, 2011, the Authority filed and served its “Objection To Petition And Request For Stay And Reconsideration Of LEAC Order”; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission hereby **ORDERS** that the “Petition for Request for Stay and Reconsideration of LEAC Order” is **DENIED**.
