**WHEREAS**, on December 19, 2014, Momentum Telecom, Inc. (hereinafter “Momentum”) filed an Application for authority to provide telecommunications services in the United States Virgin Islands with the Virgin Islands Public Services (hereinafter “PSC” or “Commission”); and

**WHEREAS**, on March 26, 2015, the Commission met in regular session in the Commission’s offices on both St. Thomas and St. Croix and heard from Momentum and the Commission’s technical consultants; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission engaged in discussion relative to the PSC’s policy on jurisdictional powers over telecommunications service providers; and


**WHEREAS**, upon review and deliberation the Commission voted to **SUSPEND** Momentum’s Application until the PSC’s next scheduled meeting; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Commission **ORDERS** that Momentum’s Application be **SUSPENDED** until the next scheduled meeting of the PSC.
